

Barn Rules/ Information for J&S Sport Horses

Hours of Operation

8 AM to 8 PM (you must leave the premises by 9 PM)

Most Important Rule: If it's not yours DON'T touch it!

Access & Parking

Access to the barn will be via the road that runs straight from Frying Pan Road up the driveway of the what used to be the Coleman's and then on the back dirt road. Driving through the subdivision is not allowed

Horse trailers may be parked on site at no charge – see Susan or John for details

Vehicles may be parked where they are not in the normal course of horse traffic

General Grounds Rules

No Smoking

No dogs allowed

Feeding

All horses will be fed plenty of grass/alfalfa/mix hay twice per day (approximately 12 hours apart)

Horses boarded in the barn will receive lunch.

Grain can be fed at owner's request and as provided by the owner shall be in Ziploc bags only.

Hay will be provided by J&S Sport Horses, unless other arrangements are made

Hay is only to be fed by agents of J&S Sport Horses (employees, owners)

Stalls

Bedding will be shavings of pine or cedar or combination as specified in contract

Stalls are cleaned once a day and new shavings will be added

Shavings are only to be added by agents of J&S Sport Horses (employees, owners)

Additional shavings can be purchased from J&S Sport Horses

Riding

You are welcomed to ride in the outdoor and indoor riding arenas as well as on surrounding trails during hours of operation, **ONLY AFTER** a waiver of liability has been signed, riding is not permitted outside of normal hours of operation unless previous arrangements have been made

Helmets are required for all mounted persons (SEI/ASTM certified)

No jumping without another rider in the ring or adult supervision

No jumping heights above 3' (unless special permission is granted in writing, see Susan for details)

Manure must be picked up in indoor arena

Please hack out in pairs or rides of greater numbers, leave a note with time departed and expected destination on the white board in the barn

Flagging is not permitted around mounted riders.

Stay out of the way of riders when lessons are in progress

Grooming

≈ The grooming areas in the barn are for the Boarders only.

No ISHA/IDA students allowed. They have a designated tack up area

≈ Cross tie areas, wash stall, and grooming stalls shall be immediately swept free of dirt and manure **immediately** after use

≈ If you own more than one horse only one horse at a time shall be in the cross ties

Turn Out

Please do not turn horses out in the arena outdoor arena. There are turnouts available. riders/horses being lunged (i.e.: one horse in arena at a time with owner/handler present)

No turnout in the indoor

If you are boarding in a stall or run, your horse must be turned out or ridden at least 4 times per week – if you cannot do this, we can for a fee – see Susan for details

Tack Room

All boarders will have access to saddle racks and bridle hooks for their convenience. Only one saddle is allowed and blankets are not to be stored in tack room.

Tack trunks of reasonable size (as decided by officials of J&S Sport Horses) are permissible

Do not leave loose items on tack room floor

Blanketing

≈ Barn and Loafing shed boarders have blanket service only. Blankets will be donned/doffed in a reasonable manner

Pastures

≈ Horses are fed hay twice daily

Runs

Horses are fed twice daily unless arranged with management

Back walkway needs to be kept clear of garbage/debris

Runs will be cleaned once a day

Offenses of Above Restrictions

Boarder will be given a verbal warning the first offense

Second offense, Boarder will be issued a written warning/reprisal letter

Third offense equals dismissal from the barn or other suitable reprimand as seen fit by the agents of J&S Sport Horses.
